Authors are invited to submit two-page abstracts (i.e. short papers), with the minimum acceptable length of 1000 words, for presentation at CANCEM 2005. Abstracts must be formatted using **these instructions** (authors will need Adobe Acrobat Reader in order to print the list of instructions). Upon review by the Technical Committee, accepted abstracts will be scheduled for presentation, and will appear in the CANCEM 2005 Proceedings.

The publication of the two-page abstract in the Proceedings of the Congress is not to be considered as a full-length paper, and does not prevent authors from submitting full-length versions to recognized peer-reviewed international journals.

Line drawings and references should be contained within the outlines shown on this **template** to ensure that the manuscript is correctly formatted. Photographs may be included if prepared in half tone screens. Authors should carefully proofread their manuscripts since reproduction will be made from the original documents.

Submissions will be accepted in French or English. If they so wish, authors may write their manuscript in French and present in English. Alternatively, authors may write in English, and present in French. No changes in the manuscript will be permitted after submission. Manuscripts, not prepared in accordance with format instructions, will not be reviewed and will be returned to the authors.

The deadline for submission of abstracts is January 15, 2005. Authors must ensure that their full mailing address appears on the manuscript.

Authors will be informed of the decision regarding their abstracts by March 1, 2003. Withdrawal of paper must be made in writing by March 15, 2003. Authors of accepted papers are expected to present their papers and must pay the full registration fee in order to have their papers appear in the Proceedings.
